### FUNDING GUIDELINES

#### **OBJECTIVE OF GRANT SUPPORT**

By way of acknowledging GAA clubs in Meath who have signed up to the Ireland Lights Up (ILU) campaign 2022, Meath LSP is providing small financial support to deflect some of the costs of operating flood lights over the 6 weeks of the campaign.

No liability for the roll out of the ILU campaign or associated costs or activities will be accepted by Meath Local Sports Partnership.

Financial support will be provided to max of €250 per club.

**Following Terms & Conditions of grant support will apply:**

#### **Who can apply?**

- GAA Clubs based in Meath (only) and affiliated to the recognised national governing body of GAA can apply. Proof to be provided if requested.
- GAA clubs must have signed up to the GAA Ireland Lights Up campaign & agree to adhere to all conditions detailed within. Proof of sign up may be requested.
- Clubs must have valid public liability insurance & relevant indemnities in place (as per Ireland Lights Up criteria).

#### **Grant Information**

- The fund is limited. Funding for successful clubs will be provided to maximum of €250
- The criteria for funding support and short-listing will consider the club's ability to co-ordinate safe and accessible walks for club members and the wider community. Preference will be given to clubs who facilitate walkers on a number of nights and/or provide walk leaders.
- Funding will be paid to each successful club following the completion of the 6 week programme.
- Each application will be dealt with on a case by case basis.
- The decision of the funding committee is final.

#### **Successful Clubs**

- Must comply with any reasonable request regarding publicity from Meath LSP.
- Must capture video footage and photos of their weekly walks, (and, if applicable from National Walk day) and tag Meath LSP into their social

media postings. Please ensure consent is received from participants for Meath LSP to share on social media.

- Must complete and return the Meath LSP Report form on completion of the 6 week programme.

### **Weekly walking programmes & National Walk day event**

- Be open to all club members and the wider community.
- Be **FREE** to participants.
- Include Meath Local Sports Partnership logo on all advertising materials.
- Ensure all Covid-19 protocols as recommended by government and the National Governing Body will be adhered to for weekly walks and national walk day
- Please note National Walk day will take place on Jan 16<sup>th</sup>, clubs are encouraged to organise a walk on this day if possible. If this date doesn't suit, clubs also have the option of hosting a walk to coincide with National Walk day over the weekend of the 15<sup>th</sup>/16<sup>th</sup> January.

Once your club is approved for grant support, you will receive the report form which will need to be completed in advance of drawdown of funding (basic form 2 pages max).
